TO: JOHN GIAMBATTISTA, Constable of the Town of Rumford, in said County.

GREETINGS:

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Registration of Voters' Office will be open during the business hours at the Municipal Building on December 13 and December 14, 2011 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to hear and decide upon applications of persons claiming the right to have their names entered upon the voting lists.

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Rumford, in said County, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to assemble at the Municipal Office Building Auditorium, in said Town, on **Thursday, the 15th day of December, A.D. 2011 at 6:00 o'clock** in the evening for a business and secret poll meeting to act on the following articles, to wit:


Article 1 : Shall the Town approve the expenditure of \$175,000 from the undesignated funds of the Town of Rumford for the replacement of a culvert and the repair of the road washout on Swain Road caused by flooding this year? [Recommendation of Board of Selectpersons: \$175,000 / Recommendation of the Finance Committee: \$175,000]

Explanation: The Town does not have enough funds from the road appropriations approved by the voters of the Town of Rumford at the June 14, 2011 secret poll meeting to replace the damaged culvert and to make repairs to the damage done to Swain Road by the washout caused by flooding this year.

Article 2: To see if the Town will authorize the Board of Selectpersons to apply for and accept funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency on behalf of the Town for federal funding assistance for which the Town is eligible due to the flood damage in the Town in such amount and under such terms as the Board of Selectpersons deem right and proper and to act on anything relating thereto.


Explanation: This will allow the Town to apply for and take advantage of federal funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency to offset the costs expended by the Town for the damages in the Town caused by flooding this year.


